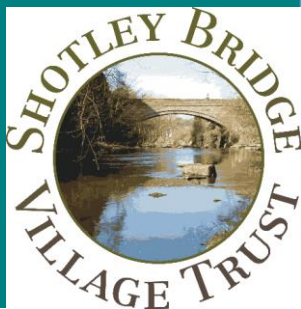




The Derwent Valley Car Club is a community-based car club, set up by Blackhall Mill Community Association.
